Quick Reference: Form 760PY - Tax Year 2024

Types:

- **Category 3:** Tax Due return received with or without payment
- Category 4: Refund returns

Process as Direct File:

- eFile indicator of **XXXXX** on Form 760PY is shown in the bottom right portion of the document below Line 12, Column C.
 - If the indicator **XXXXX** is printed on the return, highlight the indicator using a **YELLOW** highlighter.
- Return's address doesn't belong in your locality.

Key Items to Review:

- <u>Special Filing Situation</u>: Form 760PY and Form 763 were filed in the same tax year by a taxpayer.
 - Allocate withholding as applicable.
 - Make notations on both the Form 760PY and Form 763.
- Local Tax Due Returns
 - LTD bubble must be filled/"X" entered on LTD line.
 - Payment amount (or ZERO/"0") must be entered on the \$_____ line.
 - Locality Code the proper 3-digit FIPS Code must be entered.
- <u>Itemized Deductions claimed on Line 11</u> check for a Virginia Schedule A.
 - If Virginia Schedule A is missing, code "SA"
- <u>Federal Return</u> code "**FX**" if not attached.
- <u>Federal Form 1310</u>- code "**DX**" if attached.
- Dates of residence in Virginia.
- Farmer, Fisherman, and Merchant Seaman checkbox is checked:
 - Return filed on or before April 15, 2025 code "IX"
 - Return filed after April 15, 2025 code "UX"
- Ensure the "<u>Prorated Exemption Amount</u>" on Line 13 is correct.
- Review for <u>Credit for Tax Paid to Another State</u> on line 24.
 - If claimed and the total credit is equal to or greater than \$500, code "MX"
- Review <u>Schedule OSC credit amount(s)</u> and <u>Form 760PY net tax amount</u>.
- If tax amount is smaller than credit, adjust the OSC income percentage as needed.
- Form 760C or 760F if included code "CX"

Group Returns in Stacks:

- Timely Farmer, Fisherman, Merchant Seaman returns.
- Late Farmer, Fisherman, Merchant Seaman returns.
- All other screened returns to be handled as LOCAL file returns.
- Returns to be handled as **DIRECT** file returns.

Transmittal to Virginia Tax:

- Complete a LAP-SORT 1 or LAP-SORT 2 form for each stack of returns.
- Rubber band the returns in each stack together.
